

Winter School

Off-Highway Vehicle Design

An **intensive training program** taking place **between late October and early December 2025**, combining **hands-on learning**, **factory tours**, **technical workshops**, and **a team challenge** focused on the design of an off-highway vehicle and the opportunity to get feedback from and exchange ideas with experts in the field.

Hosted by the **Department of Agricultural and Food Sciences** – University of Bologna and **CNH Italia** in Modena, the Winter School is **especially aimed at students in their second or third year of a Bachelor's degree in Mechanical or Vehicle Engineering**, but is open to all students with a background in engineering or related STEM fields

The initiative, promoted by MUNER to engage new generations in sustainable vehicle design and to offer orientation opportunities toward its international Master's programs, is part of the **MUSE – Motorvehicle University Skills Empowerment project**, co-funded by the Emilia-Romagna Region and FSE+ 2021/2027.

A symbolic fee of €90 is requested to cover accessory expenses only, with all training activities offered free of charge. A maximum of 25 students will be selected based on their academic background and CV.
